Subject: Benedict portables

I am writing to share the effects of the decision that was made by the CUSD Board on February 11, 2008. It was on this date that the board voted to reassign approximately 100 students from Vista del Mar Elementary to Truman Benedict Elementary. You may already be aware that the two portables needed to accommodate the additional enrollment will not be available until December or January. I know that the school district wasn't sure we would need portables until after CSR was saved in June, but I don't understand why the school district is just now starting the rather lengthy process to get the necessary ADA improvements made.

If you review the enrollment projections that were used in the attendance boundary decision, you will see that Benedict will have this increased enrollment for two years.
(<http://www.capousd.org/attend0809.htm> click on "2008-09 Attendance Boundaries" near top of the page and see page 5 of the report.) After the two year period, Benedict will drop back down to the enrollment that we had this past school year when we were fortunate to have an empty classroom. The school district knew of this short term need for the portables. At this point, Benedict won't get the portables until we are at least 25% of the way through this period of need. I don't think waiting saved any money so I just can't quite figure out why this delay would happen.

I heard a number of times during the CSR campaign that if we didn't raise the necessary money to save 20:1, then 6 or 7 schools would have to be reconfigured to handle the larger class sizes. This was going to cost \$1,000,000 and it would be a frantic effort over the summer to make the necessary changes. Fortunately we didn't have to do that, but why wasn't Benedict being thought of with such concern as far as getting the kids in appropriate classrooms for the start of the new school year? Why would a stage room be considered an appropriate classroom?

I believe other parents have already e-mailed you about the effects on music, library use, and special programs due to having a class in the library and the stage room of the MPR. Please take a minute to think about the students from Vista del Mar. Their families were treated rather poorly during the boundary process simply because they don't pay Mello Roos. Now they show up at Benedict and their new school will be strained because we don't have the necessary classrooms to handle all the students. Some of these families have been through 3 elementary schools in the last 6 years. How could they possibly feel welcome or that the district was looking out for the best interest of their child?

One positive thing that I have encountered during this portable classroom situation is the helpful manner of Ron Lebs. Mr. Lebs was very helpful and patient in explaining how this whole portable process works and the timeline that will be associated with it. I imagine Mr. Lebs is a rather busy man and probably would appreciate it if principals could disseminate this information instead of parents calling him directly. I know the district plans to send out a letter later this week with more information regarding the portables. I think the letter is a reaction to all the calls the district and our principal have received. Better and earlier communication would have gone a long way in helping parents and teachers prepare for the year ahead.

I look forward to seeing the ADA improvements being made at Benedict and will hope for a miracle in the review process with the state architect.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In October 2001, the CUSD Board of Trustees approved the conceptual plan of the sixth high school within City of San Juan Capistrano, San Juan Hills High School. Components of the high school campus plan included all the facilities typically found at other District high schools, including instructional and office buildings, associated infrastructure and a full complement of ancillary facilities. Despite a very aggressive construction schedule, some of the ancillary facilities were not yet constructed when San Juan Hills High School opened its doors to ninth-grade students in September 2007.

One of the items on the original site development plan that has not yet been constructed is the stadium complex, inclusive of bleachers and associated concession and restroom buildings. Now, with the school open and most of the building and infrastructure nearly complete, the District is ready to move forward to complete the stadium complex for school use in the 2008 – 2009 school year.

CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS

This agenda item pertains to Board authorization to advertise for bids for the stadium complex at San Juan Hills High School. Construction documents for the stadium should be DSA-approved within the month of November 2007. The anticipated bidding and construction timeline for the project is as follows:

- December 2007 – Open bids, award the contract, authorize construction notice to proceed
- January through August 2008 – Construction of the stadium
- September 2008 – Stadium completion and opening day

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This agenda item will not impact the District's General Fund. The District has sufficient funds on deposit generated from Community Facilities District 98-2 (Ladera) to fully fund the construction of the San Juan Hills High School stadium complex. The estimated total cost is \$3 million.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully requested that Board President Sheila Benecke recognize A. Woodrow Carter, Interim Superintendent, to introduce this item. Sherry Hahn, CFO, and Joe Dixon, Executive Director II, Facilities Services, will be available to answer questions. Following a brief presentation, it is requested that the Board authorize District staff to advertise for bids for the stadium complex at San Juan Hills High School.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

San Juan Hills High School was designed, planned, and built pursuant to the approvals of several State agencies including: the California Department of Education (CDE); the Departments of Toxic Substances Control; the Division of the State Architect (DSA); and the Office of Public School Construction (OPSC).

In January 2004, Wilson Geosciences, Inc. completed a "Pipeline Risk Analysis" for a 16-inch diameter liquid petroleum product pipeline located within 1,500 feet of the north-eastern corner of the school property. Wilson Geosciences, Inc. used the CDE draft Standard Pipeline 2002 Protocol – Stage 1 and Stage 2 Analysis documents to complete this report. The analysis recommended that the CUSD and the CDE representatives discuss the protocol-developed risk levels determined to be insignificant as outlined in the report, and decide if risk levels are acceptable. On November 4, 2004, the CDE provided the district with a Site Approval letter for the San Juan Hill High School site.

On April 17, 2008, the district was notified during the Facilities Subcommittee of potential errors in the 2004 Pipeline Risk Analysis relating to a petroleum product pipeline located within 1,500 feet of the north-eastern corner of the school property. The district has been in contact with the CDE, the State Fire Marshall representative, Kinder Morgan Electrical Partners and the Assistant District Attorney regarding the finding in this report. Furthermore, this section of the school property has been closed to students and personnel use until a thorough review has been completed on the risk analysis.

In May 2008, the CUSD contracted with The Planning Center to review and revise the San Juan Hills High School Pipeline Safety Hazard Assessment (PSHA). The firm is to determine whether the pipeline shut-off valves are operated manually or automatically and whether additional petroleum product may be released, which would invalidate the assumptions used in the previous PSHA.

On June 16, 2008, the Trustees were provided updated information on the development of San Juan Hills High School as it pertains to the pipeline safety risk analysis. The Planning Center is in the process of completing a revised Risk Analysis. A copy of the Board presentation was posted for public viewing and comment and an updated risk analysis will be presented to the Board in July. Furthermore, this section of the school property has remained closed to students and personnel use until a thorough review has been completed on the risk analysis.

CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS

The purpose of this agenda item is to provide Trustees with a copy of the final revised San Juan Hills High School Pipeline Safety Risk Analysis which will be provided under separate cover, Exhibit A. This analysis will be shared with the CDE, the State Fire Marshall representative, Kinder Morgan Electrical Partners and the Assistant District Attorney regarding the finding in this report.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This agenda item does not impact the district's General Fund. The estimated cost of \$16,000 of this environmental service will be funded from the District's Capital Facilities accounts.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that the Board President recognize A. Woodrow Carter, Superintendent, who along with Ron Lebs, Deputy Superintendent of Business and Support Services, District Legal Counsel Bergman & Dacey, Inc., and The Planning Center will make a presentation related to this agenda item.

After appropriate discussion, it is respectfully recommended that the Board of Trustees accept the final Pipeline Safety Risk Analysis and have the report sent to CDE for approval.

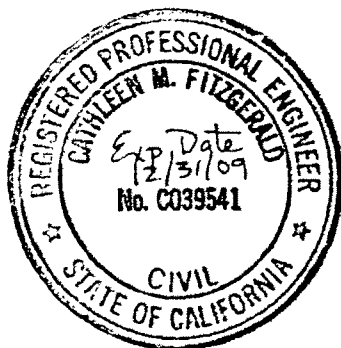
